As the weather warms up and you are ready to get out more, I want to remind you of two transportation programs offered at JSSA. Staying on the Go! is a one-on-one, two-session, program where you and/or you and your loved one can start planning for a time when you or your loved one may no longer feel comfortable driving. During the sessions, you will have an opportunity to address any anxiety around minimizing your driving, as well as to create a plan to keep you and/or your loved one mobile. Additionally, **JSSA** has a door-through-door escorted transportation program – **Brenner Transportation** for when you may be required to have an escort to a medical appointment or for when you would feel safer with an escort.


